Having considered June 14, 2005 letter application on behalf of the Citigroup Defendants ("Petitioners"), it is hereby

ORDERED that claimants ("Respondents") George Greenfield, under power of attorney for Glenn Altman, Lisa Altman, JTWROS, et. al; Succession of Hillard M. Jaik, Charlene M. Jaik, Steven A. Haik, and Holly M. Haik; and Kenneth Willard Shannon show cause before this Court on July 15, 2005, in Courtroom 11B, 500 Pearl Street, New York, New York, at 2:30 p.m. why Respondents should not be enjoined from pursuing a NASD arbitration claim against the Citigroup Defendants to the extent it relates to investments in securities issued by WorldCom.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Respondents shall submit any papers in opposition to such an injunction by 5 p.m. on July 1, 2005.


