DENISE COTE, District Judge:

On July 13, 2005, this Court issued an Order to Show Cause why certain respondents not be enjoined from pursuing a NASD arbitration claim against the Citigroup Defendants ("Petitioners") to the extent the claim relates to investments in securities issued by WorldCom (the "July 13 Order"). Opposition was to be due on July 20, 2005; any reply was due on July 26, 2005. The show cause hearing was scheduled for July 29, 2005. On July 20, 2005, the Court received an application from counsel for Roslyn Berger ("Berger"), one of the respondents to the July 13 Order, requesting additional time to prepare Berger's response. Berger's counsel indicated that the application was unopposed. It is hereby

ORDERED that, for respondent Berger, the following schedule shall supersede the schedule set forth in the July 13 Order:

Berger shall show cause before this Court at 9 a.m. on August 26, 2005, in Courtroom 11B, 500 Pearl Street, New York, New York why she should not be enjoined from pursuing a NASD arbitration claim against the Citigroup Defendants to the extent

the claim relates to investments in securities issued by WorldCom.


Berger shall submit any papers in opposition to such an injunction by August 3, 2005.

Berger may, with the consent of counsel for Petitioners, satisfy this Order without the need to attend the show cause hearing by indicating this preference in a cover letter accompanying her opposition papers.

Petitioners shall submit their reply by August 10, 2005.
