ORDER

DENISE COTE, District Judge:

The Lead Plaintiff and the Garden City Group ("GCG") have applied for approval of a final distribution to the WorldCom class in the Securities Litigation. This Order addresses the GCG recommendation that 37 claims be rejected in whole or in part because the claimants failed to provide adequate documentation.

Adequate documentation is necessary to prevent payment of fraudulent claims and to calculate payment on claims accurately. 18 of the claims at issue are not supported by any documentation; 15 have incomplete or inadequate documentation for all transactions; and 4 reflect gifts of stock without adequate documentation to support the original purchases. GCG recommends that 30 of the claims be rejected in their entirety, and that 7 be partially rejected.

GCG advised the 37 claimants of the reasons for their recommendation of complete or partial rejection and that they need not respond to obtain Court review of their claim, but that they could mail an objection to the rejection of the claim by

May 15, 2009. A few of the 37 claimants have resolved their claims, either by providing the missing information or accepting GCG's current determination.¹ None of the other claimants has sent any objection.


Having reviewed the GCG submissions regarding these 37 claims, it is hereby

ORDERED that those of the 37 claims that have not been resolved are denied, in whole or in part, as recommended by GCG.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that GCG shall send a copy of this Order to all claimants affected by it.
