DENISE COTE, District Judge:

The Lead Plaintiff and the Garden City Group ("GCG") have applied for approval of a final distribution to the WorldCom class in the Securities Litigation. This Order addresses the GCG recommendation that 13 claims be rejected because the calculation under the terms of the Plan of Allocation yielded no payment, and that 12 other claims be rejected in whole and 1 other claim be rejected in part because the securities are not eligible for recovery.

GCG advised these 26 claimants of the reasons for their recommendation of complete or partial rejection and that they need not respond to obtain Court review of their claim, but that they could mail an objection to the rejection of the claim by May 15, 2009. With one exception, none of these claimants has sent any objection.¹

¹ Lead Counsel's submissions reflect that they received a response from Marc Singer. GCG has determined that Singer sold all of his shares of common stock during the Class Period at a profit. He is therefore not entitled to any recovery, and his objection is denied.


Having reviewed the GCG submissions regarding these 26 claims, it is hereby
